Age and number of pupils	In this school due to all other control measures in place, Extended Provision runs on a ration of 1:12  If there is an occasion where there are high numbers of year R pupils, who are under 5s, enrolled at the club, the number can be capped at 8.  The Sports Clubs are run by coaching staff with level 3 qualifications and so are equipped for a ratio of 1:30  Additional coaching staff are employed for gymnastics and if the number of year R, under 4s exceeds 8 pupils.  Staff are aware of any pupils with additional needs and consult the class teacher regarding any adaptations that need to be made.  A senior member of staff is on-site at all times and available to support staff if necessary.  Staff are able to use the school's RED triangle system in an emergency.  Lone working is not permitted. Eating and food preparation	Snacks are prepared on-site. Food is stored in appropriate storage and purchased weekly. Food beyond the sell-by date is not consumed. Staff provide varied snacks that are part of a healthy balanced diet and menus are available on request Staff preparing the food have food-hygiene qualifications. Staff have access to all individual Health Care Plans and work with parents to ensure that children with special diets are appropriately catered for. Safeguarding	A DSL is always available whilst the club is open. Concerns are reported using the school's My Concern software. The school provides Safeguarding training at least annually and has up-to-date policies relating to Child Protection and Prevent. All relevant employment checks are in place and recorded on the SCR. The school completes regular site inspections to ensure the provision is safe and fit for use. All rooms have clear fire exits and routes are known to all staff.
