On occasions where larger numbers of visitors are attending site together, individual arrangements will be made regarding car parking. Staff car parking	 Staff should park in allocated places where possible. Parking on the grass is permitted if the car park is full. Driving in the car park should be a maximum of 5 miles per hour. Pupils	 Children may not enter the car park without an adult. Pupil access to the car park is restricted to regulated activities only. The gate to the car park remains shut at all times when pupils are on site. Visibility is improved in the car park by lights. 	All pupils	Ongoing	Lowrisk
School mini buses	 Pupils embarking or disembarking from the school mini buses will always be accompanied by a member of school staff. Pupils are not expected to walk across the car park; the bus pull up in front of the school building. A member of SBS staff always shuts the school gate after the last pupil has walked through the gate. Pupils to wear a seat belt when travelling on the school mini bus. Pupils not to remove their seatbelts until bus engine is turned off and the driver has told them to unfasten. 	All pupils. All staff.	Ongoing	Lowrisk

Parents are reminded to take care when pulling out of the car park entrance and requested to avoid using the entrance to the school car park as a turning circle. After School Club/ sports	 Pupils to be collected from the car park gate. Parents to wait next to the gate for pupils to be released to them. Children are only allowed to walk across the car park when accompanied by an adult. Parents should always reverse into spaces in the car park. Parents must drive at a maximum of 10 miles per hour.
