

Physical Education and Sport Funding Premium
Information – 2015 - 2016

This is an allocation of additional funding for primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all our children. The funding allocated to South Baddesley CE Primary School in 2015 – 2016 is: £9000

The funding will be allocated to the following areas:

Training and specialist sports coaching:

Cost: NFSP and Ben Strange (Monday pm)

New Forest Primary School Policy Programme- This will continue provide further access to professional development to all staff and provide new planning resources so that children across the school have equal access to on-going, high quality PE and Sports. Alongside this we will continue to work with our local cluster schools to develop opportunities to enter local competitions; this year we will introduce KS1 competitions. All KS2 will receive additional blocks of sports coaching from a specialist coach during the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms.

Staffing:

Coaching:

Following the success of appointing a Sports Event Leader (2014-15) we will continue to develop this role. This enables pupils to enter a greater range of competitions and to offer more opportunities for extra-curricular coaching. Opportunities are tracked, evaluated and improvements made.

Resources:

Cost:

Some additional resources have been purchased to develop pupil's skills and also to introduce new sports to children. These resources include the development of a target throwing area outdoors and the improvement of the current climbing equipment.

Evaluation:

We will evaluate the impact of this funding through:

- Feedback about PE lessons from staff and pupils, as well as feedback from parents at Parent Forum,
- Monitoring number of children competing in sports competition,
- Pupil attitude questionnaires.
