PE and Sports Premium Funding  
2017-18



Sports Premium funding was introduced to schools in 2013; it is an allocation of funding to support the development of Sport and PE across the school.

**The funding can be used for:** making additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport you offer.

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that your school already offers
- build capacity and capability within the school to ensure that improvements made now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical
- the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport

### **SBS Success**

The PE and Sports Premium Funding has enabled South Baddesley to make a number of improvements to the provision of PE and Sports.



### **Activity Track**

In July 2014 we installed an activity track. We use this as a running and walking track all year round. This helps significantly as our field becomes very wet and soggy in the winter. It also provides a track to complete distance running on.

### **Extra Curricular Provision**

We have significantly increased the number of additional activities available to children and many of these are sporting opportunities. Some of this provision is provided through external providers and some of this is provided by school. We have had particular successes with the development of running with two children successfully representing the New Forest within the Hampshire Games.

### **Sports Leader Role**

In 2014 we successfully created a Sports Leader role. This has led to us joining the New Forest Sports Partnership and providing opportunities for children from years 1 to 6 participating in competitive activity. As a consequence we have achieved a Sports Quality Mark and achieved success within the local league table. We currently commit to one competitive sports activity a month.

### **Enrichment Sport and Visitors to our school**

We offer enhanced PE and Sport provision at KS2. Children receive their standard two hour PE and Sports lesson each week and throughout each term they receive blocks of enrichment sports activity. These sessions are led by qualified sports coaches both internally and externally. We have used some of the funding to improve the qualifications of sports teachers. In addition to this we have used some of our Community Assemblies to welcome individuals to talk about their journeys with sport. These visitors have included Olympic sailors and triathletes, past pupils climbing expeditions and success with cricket as well as gymnastics coaches and football coaches. We are always looking for inspiring people to talk to our children. We regularly enable pupils to share their sporting successes through this forum too.

## 2017-2018 is the SBS YEAR OF SPORT....



This year we are working in partnership with the Friends of SBS, New Forest Sports Partnership and other local providers of sport to develop further both the PE and Sports Curriculum but also opportunities for families to engage in sporting activities.

### **Our priorities are:**

- ⇒ Introduce Pupil Sports Ambassadors and a team of parent coaches.
- ⇒ Provide further extra curricular sporting activities through clubs and competitions, including the New Forest Netball League. As well as introducing family sporting activities.
- ⇒ Continue to improve provision for sport within the grounds and increasing the range of equipment we have available.
- ⇒ Continuing to develop the professional development of staff.
- ⇒ Continuing to enhance PE and Sport through enhanced provision both at
