Class: Aslan		Topic: Why should we thank the ancient Greeks?			
<p>Hook: The children will be given a range of statements and resources to find out whether they originated from Ancient Greece or not. Children will use their historical understanding to explain their reasoning and justify their thoughts. Were they right with what they thought the Greeks did 3000 years ago?</p>		<p>Outcome: For children to plan an Ancient Greek museum. In this plan, they must think about all the important influences they have learnt about and which of these they feel are important enough to go in this museum. They must plan what type of information they would have on display and how they would lay it out.</p>

<p>Opportunities for English (AfL links): In Literacy this half term we will be looking at Macbeth. The outcome for our unit will be a discussion text to discuss how much of a part Lady Macbeth had to play in Duncan's death, even though she didn't actually kill him. We will spend time looking into characters in the story and their actions by hot-seating, role plays and diary entries. We will also look at how to layout a discussion text, using point evidence, explain to help to support our answers. When appropriate, we will use our Literacy skills during topic lessons. During guided reading sessions, we will delve deeper into the text, looking at vocabulary choices and language used by the author. We will also develop our skills of using evidence to support the questions we have answered.</p>		<p>Opportunities for mathematics (AfL links): We will continue this half term with looking at multiplication and division skills and learning methods in which we can solve problems. We will use our understanding of times tables and procedures to solve trickier problems. We will also look at problems set in different contexts and problems that involve using our reasoning skills to solve. This will then test our understanding of the operations. Then we will move onto fractions, decimals and percentages and learn the relationships between these. We will be tested weekly on our times tables to secure our understanding to then help us with our problem solving.</p>
