

# SOUTH BADDESLEY SCHOOL SAILING AT THE SALTERNS

**For SBS children, Year 2 & upward**

Every Tuesday between 18.00 and 19.30 (from Easter to October Half Term), South Baddesley School children from Year 2 and upward can enjoy the wonderful facilities of the Salterns Sailing Club in Lymington. Learn to row a boat or sail an Optimist dinghy in the safe environment of a 3-foot deep lake.

Children must be able to swim at least 10m unaided and be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult. Parents must provide suitable clothing and safety equipment – and your active support is encouraged, on and off the water. A knowledge of dinghy sailing is not required, just a willingness to get involved.

The objective is for the children to have fun and build their confidence on the water.

**TOTAL COST for the SUMMER SEASON IS £33 PER CHILD.** If you're a full member of Salterns Sailing Club there is no charge, but you'll still need to come along to the introductory session on the 17<sup>th</sup> April to register.

**TO FIND OUT MORE and to REGISTER, come along (children and parents) to the INTRODUCTORY SESSION (no sailing) on TUESDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2018, at Salterns Sailing Club.** We'll run through the format of the weekly sessions and kit lists, and you'll have the chance to ask questions, make payment and fill out the necessary paperwork.
