**Task 2:** To support our work on Polar Bears, we would like to encourage the children to find out as much as possible about the life of a Polar Bear.



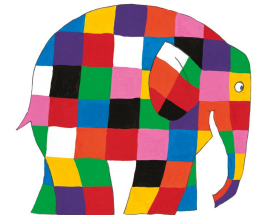
- What is it like in their habitat?
