Find 9 o'clock on an analogue clock face.

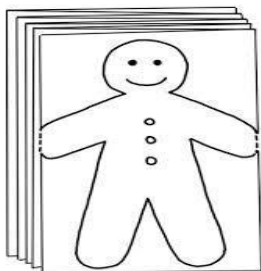
Practice writing the numeral '9' and the word 'nine' in your workbooks.
