Summer Week 3 – Lesson 2 – Compare and order fractions

English:

LO: To explore techniques used by the writer to influence the reader's opinions.

Today we will be looking at Chapter 3. Please listen to or read chapter 3 first. Hopefully by now you are starting to get an idea of what Willie is like and are building up an idea about what his life could have been like in London before he came to stay with Mr Tom, from clues in the text. It is very sad. However, again from clues in the text, you might be starting to get an idea as to how his life might change.

Today we are going to explore how Michelle Magorian has used specific language to tell us more about characters so that we, as a reader, can build a picture in our minds about them.

On Learners Pool in English> Goodnight Mr Tom> Goodnight Mr Tom Chapter 3, I have given you a copy of the 1st few paragraphs from the chapter. Once you have read it, pick 4 colours and allocate them to the key at the bottom of the page, then highlight the evidence on page to show each statement. You can either print this off and use highlighters or do it straight on the computer. (Remember to make a copy of the document and save it in your folder in the pool).

Then, if you have time, you can answer the question:

- How do we know that Willie is frightened and in pain?

Use Point, Evidence, Explain to structure your answer and develop it as much as you can.
