I hope you guys are all OK today. For our learning today, we are going to do some maths and topic. In topic we will be learning about The Blitz.

Maths:

LO: To divide fractions by integers

All your work is still saved on the Drive in the maths folder. The link is on the document named video links. Again, if you would like to do some extra work on dividing fractions by integers, there is some more videos and work sheets on BBC Bitesize, Year 6. This is only if you would like to, it is not compulsory.

Topic:

LO: To find out about The Blitz during WW2.

I have been really enjoying see all the work on WW2 you have uploaded to Learners Pool. Some of your topic scrap books are looking incredible and you should be really proud of them.

I am going to give you two days to do this task again.

Today, we are going to finding out about the Blitz and how it affected the people of Britain.

- The first thing you will need to do is look at the PowerPoint named 'The Blitz' in the WW2 Folder, The Blitz. This will give you information you will need about it.
- Next, there is an extract from a journalist, writing about the Blitz. Read through this. It will give you a 1st hand account of what it must have felt like during the Blitz.
- For your task, I would like you to write a paragraph or two for your topic book, answering the question 'What was the Blitz?'.
- The final task is an Art task. I have uploaded a PowerPoint of finished picture examples so you can see what you are aiming for.

In order to do this, you will need to create a back ground of a sunset and use reds, oranges and yellows. You could use crayons, chalks, pastels, paints – whatever you have at home. Some you ICT people could think of a way to do this on the computer too.

Then I have attached some silhouette outlines of planes and prominent London buildings. You could draw your own and colour them in black or print off and cut out the silhouettes. You will need to attach these to the bottom of your background. You now should have created your London skyline during the Blitz.

This final picture will go into your topic book along with your information about the Blitz. You may wish to add any further information or pictures to this too.

Hope you enjoy this. I would love to see some finished masterpieces so please upload them to Learners Pool.

Optional Extra (if you fancy something else!):

Mrs Mitchell has let me know that Friday is Endangered Species Day and wondered if Year 6 would like to do anything for this.

We thought it would be a great idea to research an endangered animal and find out a little more about them. Then present your findings in a poster to let other members of the class know about them too, to raise awareness of the species.

Things you may like to research:

- Where they live
- What they eat
- Why they are endangered
- What could be done to help save them
- Any other interesting facts you may find out about them.
