Class: Aslan		Topic: Our World			
<p>Hook: Children are to design and explain their perfect island. What would they have there and why? What would it look like? What features will it have? From this, they will start to look and compare their island to Easter Island.</p>		<p>Outcome: Children are to research about a renewable energy type of their choice and present their findings to the class.</p>

<p>Opportunities for English (AfL links): In Literacy, the children will be looking at the story of The Last Wild by Piers Torday. They will be finding out about the characters, plot and settings of the story. During the unit, they will learn about how to use cohesive devices within their writing to create flow and how to use show me, don't tell me devices to show feelings and emotions of characters. The outcome of the unit will be to write their own chapter of the book. Spellings and grammar will also be taught within lessons.</p>		<p>Opportunities for mathematics (AfL links): For maths, children will be recapping and extending their knowledge of place value to ensure they are secure with this knowledge. They will then look at the four operations (+, -, x and ÷) and learn to use the most efficient method for a variety of questions and problems. Children will continue to learn their times tables and be tested weekly on these.</p>

<p>Science: We will learn that light travels in straight lines; light reflects off all objects (unless they are black); non-shiny surfaces scatter the light so we don't see a single beam; animals see light sources when light travels from the source into their eyes; animals see objects when light is reflected off that object and enters their eyes. This key knowledge will be explored through solving three problems.</p>		<p>History: Children will find out about the story behind Easter Island and will link this history to their Geography based topic to learn why it is important to manage natural resources carefully.</p>		<p>Geography: In geography, Year 6 will be finding out about renewable and non-renewable energy the effects that they have on the planet. They will visit a solar farm and learn about fat fashion and its impact.</p>	
<p>RE: In RE, Year 6 will be looking at Creation and Science. Is it conflicting or complementary?</p>		<p>ICT: Year 6 will be finding out how to be safe online and the importance of e-safety.</p>		<p>Other: In PE, Year 6 will be developing their team and ball skills and will be participating in some games of netball.</p>
